VACCINE

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Many of you have expressed an interest in having your child(ren) vaccinated at a Federally Funded school-based clinic. For those that have returned your Informed Consent to the school, Thank You!

At this time the information for our students is as follows: Our Lady of Lourdes, Joyce Kilmer and Parkview school students will received their vaccines at a borough clinic held at Parkview School, Violet Terrace, Milltown. All school-based clinics are being administered by each municipality's Office of Emergency Management (OEM). Each OEM is working in conjunction with the Middlesex County Health Department and each school's nurse.

The H1N1 vaccine clinic for all registered OLOL students is mid-November. The clinics will be held after school hours and also on Saturday (dates to be announced). Each recipient must come with their parent or guardian. A fully completed Informed Consent is required to be on file in the school office by November 2nd for each child. We will **NOT** have extra vaccines. Vaccines are available for school-age children only. Pre-school ages 24-59 months and those in high school to age 24 may contact the Middlesex County Health Department to schedule an appointment to receive a vaccine at the Jersey Avenue Clinic in New Brunswick; www.co.middlesex.nj.us/publichealth.

If you have any interest in participating in this school-based clinic, and have not yet sent in your consent form, please print and complete the Informed Consent from our website, www.ololschoolnj.org. If your child has received a seasonal flu vaccine, please note the date and type (shot or mist). **ALL consents must be in the school office by Monday, November 2, 2009 in order to advise the OEM of any additional doses needed for OLOL students.**
