



Computer Class – Avatar Project Grades PreK-8

The theme for Catholic Schools Week is: Faith, Academics, Service.

During computer class, the student will be creating an avatar that will be showcased during the week of January 29th – February 5th. All avatars should have the same beginning: “Hi. My name is XXXXX and I am in the # grade.” The remaining information will describe why the student loves/likes/enjoys attending Our Lady of Lourdes School that describes their experience of learning about Faith, Academics and/or Service. The content needs to be describing one or more areas of the theme and not about the great food, many friends or feeling of family, etc. The avatar will be a character that represents a student and of good taste (i.e. the avatar will not have tattoos or is an animal, etc.)

The written portion of this project (back of this form) needs to be completed and returned to Mrs. Florczak no later than Tuesday, January 17, 2012.

Helpful questions to help the student:

Faith: How does your teacher(s) help you to have a relationship with God? What activities do you participate in during school that increases your faith in God?

Academics: What exciting things do you do at school that helps you learn more about any subject area (Math, Science, Computers, etc)? How do the teachers at Our Lady of Lourdes School work with you daily to be the best student that you can be?

Service: How does the school help you to see the benefits of giving more of one’s time and effort to help others. How does this relate to your faith and being a good citizen?
