

SNOW ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear Our Lady of Lourdes Parents,

For snow closings, a decision will be made by Sister Maria by 5:30 AM as to whether or not school will be in session for that particular day. In order to obtain this information about school closings, listed below are the various options for delayed opening or inclement weather:

- 1) Honeywell Instant Alert Announcement (make sure you signed up!)
- 2) Our website at www.ololschoolnj.org
- 3) WCTC Radio Website at www.wctcam.com
- 4) Go to the WCTC link on our school website www.ololschoolnj.org
- 5) Channel 12 (for cable subscribers only)
- 6) WCTC Radio at 1450 AM

Delayed opening time is **9:30 AM**. Please be advised that it is possible that a delayed opening can become a full day closing if the weather conditions worsen, so check the above sources again before sending your child to school.

Note: If you are a resident of North Brunswick, please carefully read the attached letter that was given to OLOL from the Transportation Department of North Brunswick. It should clarify any questions you may have about the bus schedule for delayed openings and/or school closings.

Clarification of delayed openings and school closings.

In the event of inclement weather the following schedules will be followed.

If O.L.L. is on a regular schedule and North Brunswick is closed there will be no transportation for North Brunswick students to O.L.L.,

If O.L.L. is on regular schedule and North Brunswick is on a 90 min. delayed opening. There will be transportation for North Brunswick students but it will run on a 90 min delay.

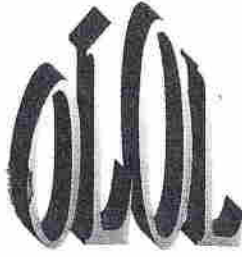
If O.L.L. is on a delayed opening and North Brunswick is on a regular schedule there will be transportation for North Brunswick students run on a 90 min delay.

Dear Parents/Guardians:

As you are aware of circumstances as seen on TV or in print, there is a possibility that a conflict could result in a domestic incident. We want to assure you that the Faculty and Staff are prepared to care for your children until you are able to get them. Please know that the care and love of your child is our primary concern.

Therefore, the purpose of this letter is not to alarm you, but to assure you that there is adequate preparation. If school was in session and a **RED ALERT** was issued for our area, OLOL, along with all other schools in the area, would be in **LOCKDOWN MODE**. In a **LOCKDOWN**, no one will be permitted to enter or leave the building. We will not release your child(ren) to you or to anyone during a **LOCKDOWN**. Once the situation is ascertained, and the police give their approval, we will begin to release students. The length of the **LOCKDOWN** will be determined by government authorities, not by us. **IN THE EVENT OF A LOCKDOWN, DO NOT COME TO OLOL TO PICK UP YOUR CHILDREN.**

Since the school will be locked down in the event of a Red Alert, know that we have an adequate supply of drinking water and nonperishable food. All of the students and the faculty will be moved to a safe location. The Office of Emergency Management will inform parents of all situations related to the schools. We will also send out a Honeywell Instant Alert as soon as possible to let parents know of the situation. Emergency Alert radio stations serving Middlesex County are WCTC 1450 AM and WMGQ 98.3 FM. As a precaution, if your child is on medication, I strongly suggest that you provide the school nurse with a three day supply of medication.

Obviously, if a Red Alert for our area is called while school is not in session, all classes and school activities will be cancelled until the Red Alert status has changed.

As a society, we have entered into an era of uncertainty and fear. Together we will provide a stable and safe environment for your child(ren). Thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding.

May God Bless and keep us safe.
